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Designing and building such a facility, Patriarche had to make every effort to ensure both rest for the patients and the people accompanying them, as well as the patients' care by trained staff.

To give this support, the building, which is far from Lyon's noisy city centre, has a pleasant, relaxing, and near hotel-standard interior where technical spaces are inconspicuous.

The architecture of the building, made available by the BioMérieux company and supported by the Fondation France Répit (France Répit Foundation), is designed to provide a soothing, home-like atmosphere and discreet care.

Spaces designed to facilitate interaction: living area, activity room, dining room opening onto a large outdoor terrace and the surrounding woods.

The respite care centre of Lyon has developed modern, bright and friendly spaces, where life can be organised at the pace of each person: family rooms and studios, relaxation and well-being areas, restaurant, shared living spaces, etc.

Care structures that are not very visible: wooden framework, technical rooms for air treatment in particular, hidden under the roof.

The place includes a permanent medical structure with trained and discreet staff and medical beds.

The project proposes a "home" atmosphere far from the hospital atmosphere, the priority being given to well-being, tranquillity and conviviality, the care being programmed with respect to this atmosphere.





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
