Intentions - Our approach

The ground floor layout [1] was redesigned to restore the building's connection with the street. The entrance hall has been significantly opened up and now offers level access directly from the street.

On the upper floors [2], the workspaces have been made more functional by freeing up volumes across seven office levels, while the landings bring together service areas around a newly opened-up courtyard.

The balconies have been reclaimed, and a rooftop terrace has been created to offer users exceptional views over central Paris. Raw materials and exposed ceilings to highlight the original structure.













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
