The project to build the future Chablais child psychiatry center has a bold ambition: to be a facility that takes care of its patients and staff, while at the same time being a high-performance work tool and a secure, fulfilling place to be.

Located at the gateway to the town of Thonon-les-Bains, the project pays particular attention to sustaining a warm and welcoming landscape atmosphere.

Due to its geographical location, the site unfolds around natural and urban constraints. To provide a reassuring setting for patients, the main facade protects the two day hospital courtyards on the first floor. The building is designed in a comb shape, so that the day units wrap around their respective courtyards, offering a solid framework, a protective, containing envelope.

### **Architecture that cares**

Materials were carefully selected to meet safety, durability and ease of maintenance requirements. In addition to their environmental qualities, they also create a warm ambience, notably by leaving the wood exposed in certain rooms.

Particular attention is also paid to patients' spatial cues. The creation of a sensory signage plan on every floor means that children of all ages can find their bearings and feel safe, and can easily reproduce the route to their unit by touch.









## A landscape for living, a garden for caring



Conceived as a veritable garden of sensations, the outdoor space offers a wealth of opportunities for play and discovery based on touch, taste and smell. The landscape also supports a "tableau" function, which can be contemplated from the windows. The idea is to integrate symbolic elements from the surrounding landscape and reproduce them on a smaller scale in the themed gardens. In this way, a whole universe of imagination and discovery is offered to children around the mountain, nature and market gardening.
